


There is no counter subject but this figure, taken from the tail of the subject is featured throughout the work


A real answer is one in which the intervals in the answer are exactly the same as those in the subject. A tonal answer is one in which one or more intervals are changed to accommodate the key or tonality.




Stretto at the distance of one bar (4 beats)
